## ROB TRUMBULL JOINS THE KELLY MUSIC FOR LIFE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

He was township commissioner representing the 3rd Ward for 12 years and was active in the effort to develop and protect Haverford Reserve. He has served on the boards of Delaware County Habitat for Humanity and The Village (formerly Presbyterian Children's Village). Trumbull is a high school history teacher at Episcopal Academy. Rob is married to his wife Priscilla and they have two adult married children and one grandchild.

Rob Trumbull voiced his excitement to join Kelly Music for Life. "This group is making valuable contributions to the Haverford Township community. The venue planned for the Oakmont section will provide musicians and artists, both aspiring and veterans, a valuable outlet for their talents. I look forward to contributing to the further success of this organization."

Chairman and Executive Director Tom Kelly sees the new seat on the board as a reflection of the organization's growth. "As we continue to expand Kelly Music for Life and our initiatives, we need strong, experienced board members who appreciate our arts objectives and are passionate about
