Havertown, PA - Tuesday December 4th, 2017 – The Kelly Center – Music, Arts, Community has begun its capital campaign to support the development, design, and opening of the Kelly Center at 4 E. Eagle Rd in Havertown PA in 2018.

The **Conshohocken Brewing Company**, 739 E. Elm St, Conshohocken PA has announced a **GIVE BACK NIGHT** to help raise funds for the Kelly Center. On Monday, Dec 11th, from 4 to 10 PM, Conshohocken Brewing Company will donate 20% of all food and drink sales to the Kelly Center as well as host Kelly Music For Life for a fun evening of music, food, drink, games, and Monday Night Football.

Conshohocken Brewing Company will soon be opening [Town Tap by Conshohocken Brewing Co.](#) at 13 Benedict Ave in Havertown, two blocks from the Kelly Center. **Glen Macnow**, WIP Radio Personality & Conshohocken Brewery Owner said "Havertown has become a hub for fun pubs, good restaurants and family fun in recent years. What it needs is a thriving spot for live entertainment. The planned Kelly Center is going to provide the opportunity for local musicians to show their stuff and audiences of all ages to enjoy great music."

John Byrne's latest release, "The Immigrant and the Orphan" has been called "a gorgeous, nostalgic....everything that tugs at your soul and spills your blood and guts" (That Music Mag) and a "powerful, deeply moving work that will stay with you long after you have heard it" (Sing Out). Following up 2011's After the Wake and 2013's Celtic Folk, it was released to a sold-out World Café Live in Sept 2015 and a sold-out Mercantile in Dublin, Ireland. Both as a solo/acoustic act, and a full 6-piece band, John logs in over 150 shows per year, building a loyal and devoted following. His next record, "The Rag and Bone Man", is scheduled for release late 2017/early 2018.

Seamus Kelleher toured the US in 1974 with a band called Rock & Roll Circus. Shortly after the tour, he packed his bags and moved to New York where once again he quickly developed a large following. He performed all over the US and Europe with the Sean Fleming Band. In 1996 he joined forces with Blackthorn, Philadelphia's legendary Celtic Rock band. Seamus did more than a thousand shows with Blackthorn. In 2010, Seamus decided it was time to embark on a solo career. In just a few short years, he has put together a show that combines comedy, storytelling, virtuoso guitar playing and a wonderful collection of original and unique cover material.

From **Tom Kelly**, Chairman and Executive Director of Kelly Music For Life stated: "Conshohocken Brewing is helping to make Havertown a better place by hosting a fundraiser to benefit the Kelly Center. Our good friend John Byrne will perform live to support the evening as well. It will offer a preview of good things to come in 2018 – both at the Kelly Center and at Conshohocken Brewing's new Town Tap scheduled to open in Havertown next year."

The Kelly Center, an initiative of Kelly Music For Life Events, will be an indoor public gathering space where youth and families can participate in the arts in a drug and alcohol-free environment. At the Center, we will encourage young student artists to develop their skills and participate in performance opportunities, and seniors, adults, and families to enjoy the arts together.

The Kelly Center will present the best area professional performers in all genres at night to bring great entertainment to Havertown.
